Instructions to Authors

The articles/research papers should be original and should not have been published before in any of the print or electronic media. The author should also submit a certificate stating the originality of the article/research paper.

- a) The general pattern of the article/research paper should be:
 - Title
 - Name and affiliations of the author/ authors
 - Abstract in not more than 250 words
 - Keywords: 4-6
 - Full Text in not more than 6000 words
 - Notes and References
- b) Article/research paper should be typewritten in MS Word or Page-maker format, with 1.5 line spacing, Times New Roman font size 12. The pages should be continuously numbered.
- c) Formatting styles to be used:
 - For Scientific Papers: APA Style
 - For papers in Arts, Humanities and Social sciences: MLA Style
- d) Submission of articles:
 - Articles should be submitted online in the Journal web page at <http://brennencollege.ac.in/journal/submit-articles>
 - Abstract and keywords are to be submitted separately in the given format.
 - The full text, **with no indications about the details of the author**, should be uploaded separately.
- e) Acceptance procedure:
 - The submitted articles will be reviewed by two reviewers.
 - The reviewers may recommend the article either for:
 - i. Publication without any change
 - ii. Publication with minor changes
 - iii. Major changes are required before publication
 - iv. Rejection of article
 - All articles that requires major changes are to be corrected by the author and are to be reviewed again for publication.

- Once the article is accepted for publication, it will be sent to the author for proof reading. The author should complete proof reading and submit it back within the prescribed time.

f) Certificate by the author: Each article should accompanied by a certificate as follows:

Publication Ethics

All kinds of research misconduct, including data fabrication, falsification, plagiarism, image manipulation, unethical research, biased reporting, authorship abuse, redundant or duplicate publication, and undeclared conflicts of interest, will not be tolerated and the committee would have right to initiate action, including legal, against such misconducts. A statement from the author and/or competent authority is needed, if they would like to publish research findings involving human participants and medical interventions.
