Report of Extension Activities

2014-15

Under the Swachh Bharath Scheme, road cleaning drive was undertaken by NSS volunteers. They also undertook the cleaning of Thalassery Railway station premises. Combined annual training camp was organized by NCC in which more than 700 cadets participated. NCC volunteers acted as facilitators for 35th National Games. Dept. of Chemistry organized soap making and water analysis which benefitted the larger community. NCC volunteers participated in the passing out ceremony of Navel Academy, Ezhimala, Payyannur. Department of Chemistry organized an awareness programme against plastics.

2015-16

The College Union organized an event in which issues and harassment suffered by transgender community was highlighted. An interaction with a transgender activist followed. Anti ragging campaign and a book exhibition on wheels and a film fest was also held by the union. More than 100 agencies including ISRO and Medical College participated in Brennen Expo organized in connection with 125th Anniversary of the college. A Book fair, Literary Fest, Drama Festival, Artist Collective camp etc were also organized in connection with this. Blood Donation, green Village, Clean Village campaign, cleaning of Thalasser hospital premises etc were organized by NSS. A nature education camp with the support of Kerala Forest and Wild Life department was also organised.

2016-17

Visits to old age homes in association with pain and palliative care, Traffic rule awareness with the police department, Beach cleaning Drive with Tourism Department under Swachh Bharath Scheme, Anti Drug campaign with the Excise Department, An AIDS day awareness programme in association with IMA etc were some of the activities undertaken by NSS units. A nature Camp was organized by the Department of Botany for plant identification.

2017-18

Aids day Awareness, Celebration of environment day, blood donation camp, Breast Cancer awareness programme, Eye testing camp, visit to Malabar Cancer Centre etc were some of the activities organized by the NSS and NCC units. Higher Secondary Teachers' Transformation Programme was organized. A language development programme called LEAP was organized by the department of English.

2018-19

An organic farming awareness programme called Jaivam 2018 was organized in association with Dharmadam Panchayath and Kannur University.
